The way I see it, this two—week international mobility programme is not just a platform for participants to expand their knowledge about Sarawak but a practical avenue to develop networking opportunities that will help to strengthen international bonds, foster cultural awareness, and promote each other's countries as well.

- 19. This year, Malaysia is expected to have a significant recovery in tourism. We are targeting at least 16.1 million foreign visitors which would bring in RM 49.2 billion in tourism revenue. For us in Sarawak, we are expecting 3 million tourist arrivals in 2023.

- 20. I understand that our guests and participants would be attending sessions presented by knowledgeable speakers virtually and physically.
- 21. I was also informed that they will learn to speak Sarawakian Malay, discover our cultural arts and crafts, dances, and musical instruments, and experience our cuisines and go on outdoor adventures during this two—week programme.
- 22. So, once again, I would like to congratulate the organising committee from UiTM Sarawak, and everyone involved for their hard work and dedication in ensuring the success of this programme.
- 23. To all participants, I hope that you will find the experience in Sarawak rewarding. If you enjoy the
