- Throughout its 66 years, UiTM has been at the forefront of producing competent and capable graduates in various disciplines. To date, we have an alumni strength of over 600,000.

In line with our vision to be a globally renowned university in science, technology, humanities, and entrepreneurship, we have been working closely with local and international academic and industry partners. We are steadfast and focused on our goal of producing quality and highly skilled human capital.
- On the research front, currently, UiTM has established 13 Centres of Excellence (CoE) to promote research and development. These establishments are aligned with our objective to

- Two of these CoEs The Integrative Pharmacogenomics Institute, more fondly known as iPROMISE, and the Atta-Ur-Rahman Institute, or AURINS, were born, so to speak, from UiTM's Faculty of Pharmacy.

UiTM's research initiatives have led to various praiseworthy achievements including a record of more than 16,000 indexed publications for the past 5 years as well as securing more than 4000 active research grants. Such achievements have aided in improving our academic standing where we are now ranked 104 in the QS Asia University Rankings 2023.
